


# How to Improve at Every Level

## Terms to Know

- Language descriptor-a way that your language is measured according to the ICAO language proficiency descriptors.
- Pronunciation- refers to the way your words sound, not necessarily the way you speak, how fast or slow, but the way that you pronounce your words and where intonation or words stress might be used
- Structure- refers to grammar and your ability to use grammar correctly. Furthermore, how strong your grammar is, if you move into advanced grammar, or if you don't
- Vocabulary-refers to your word choice and making sure you a word that is as descriptive as possible
- Fluency- refers to how comfortably you speak; do you stumble for words?
- Comprehension-refers to what you do and don't understand; also how well you communicate what you do and don't understand to the examiner
